THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Communities and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the Communities laid down by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68¹, as last amended by Regulation (Euratom, ECSC, EEC) No 1601/75², and in particular Article 3 thereof and Article 94 of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the Communities;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas, by Regulation No 10/63/Euratom³, as last amended by Regulation (Euratom) No 1863/74⁴, the Council laid down the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Research Centre employed at Geel-Mol;

Whereas the changes in salaries made in 1975 in favour of the staff of the Belgian Centre for Nuclear Studies (CNS) justify a further amendment to Regulation No 10/63/Euratom;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation No 10/63/Euratom shall be amended as follows:

The third subparagraph of Article 3 is hereby repealed and shall be replaced by the following subparagraph:

"Each member of the establishment staff shall receive for the year 1975 a single allowance corresponding to his basic salary for the month of June 1975, adjusted to take account of the cost-of-living index for that month. This allowance shall be subject to the deduction of social security contributions. Where the staff member entered or left this employment in the course of 1975, the single allowance shall be paid on a pro rata basis according to the length of service in that year."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
